


Acknowledgements

- **Experience** is one component of your OT CAS Application
 - You can have a lot of experiences, but other areas of your application that need attention too
 - Your experiences **do not have to be OT related**
- **Gap Year:** It's okay to not go into OT school right away!
- When asking about experience opportunities, There is a chance that you might get **"rejected"** but eventually you will get a **YES!**






